Membership Agreement & Community Guidelines

Welcome to the Indriya Shuddhi Sangha.

This Sangha is a living practice community dedicated to the regular revision, chanting, contemplation, and discussion of sacred stotrams. Membership is intended to support disciplined sādhanā and the cultivation of clarity, devotion, and refined perception.

Purpose

The Sangha exists to deepen understanding through repetition, contemplation, and shared inquiry. It is not a certification programme, nor is it intended to replace personal practice.

The dakshina you pay is not for the meaning & knowledge of the stotrams, but for the sacred community space and time where revision and contemplation can occur with the guide and others.

Membership

Membership remains active while subscription payments are current.

Members receive access only to the resources included in their current membership. Access may end if membership is cancelled or expires.

Community Culture

Members agree to:

- Treat every participant with respect and courtesy.
- Maintain confidentiality regarding personal experiences shared within the Sangha.
- Honour differences in interpretation without argument or hostility.
- Ask questions with sincerity and openness.
- Avoid comparing spiritual experiences or claiming superiority.
- Refrain from unsolicited teaching, coaching, or giving medical or psychological advice.

Chanting & Contemplation Etiquette

Members are encouraged to arrive on time, participate with presence, maintain a quiet environment during chanting, and avoid multitasking while attending live sessions.

Sacred Integrity

The stotrams and contemplative teachings are offered with reverence for their traditional sources. Members are asked not to alter the texts during group practice or represent Sangha teachings publicly as their own.

Intellectual Property

Recordings, commentaries, study notes, chants, presentations, and other learning resources are provided solely for members of the Sangha.

They may not be copied, redistributed, recorded, translated for commercial purposes, or taught publicly without written permission.

Educational Disclaimer

The Sangha supports spiritual study and disciplined practice. It does not provide medical, therapeutic, psychological, legal, or financial services.

Removal from the Sangha

To preserve a safe and respectful learning environment, membership may be suspended or terminated if a participant engages in harassment, discrimination, repeated disruption, unauthorised sharing of materials, or conduct that undermines the purpose of the Sangha.
